Thank you for your interest in attending a Steve Lantvit clinic, at Highgrove Farm, in LaPorte Indiana. This packet along with total amount due is required to be registered. We look forward to having you at the clinic and are committed to making it a memorable learning experience. Please call us if you have any questions.

Details:

- Cost per rider \$550. If registered/paid BEFORE March 1st, 2026, fee is \$500 instead of \$550.
- Includes clinic fee, complementary lunch, stall/paddock for horse, and water/electric for living quarters trailers.
- Clinics runs from 9am – 5pm CDT each Day
- We go out for dinner as a group Friday and Saturday night to a local restaurant. **Please bring cash for dining because most restaurants no longer split bills.**

Clinic Arrivals:

- Check-in time is between 3pm CDT – 8pm CDT the day prior. We'd appreciate it if you could do your best to arrive within this time.
- Special arrangements need to be made if you are checking in BEFORE 3pm CDT the day prior to the clinic OR if you are requesting to stay an additional night AFTER the clinic.

What to Bring to Clinic:

- Copy of Proof of Negative Coggins and Health Certificate if coming in from out of state
- Hay/grain for horses, Buckets for feed and water
- Free-standing Saddle rack to store saddle in barn
- Bring tack; saddle, pad, bridle, halter & leadline
- **As much as we love dogs, we ask that your dog remains at home**

Cancellation Policy: Clinic will be held rain or shine. In the event you need to cancel, a refund will not be given.

1). I have read and understand, and freely and voluntarily enter into this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement with Highgrove Farm Inc. and Steve Lantvit Horsemanship Inc., understanding that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement is a waiver of any and all liability (ies).

2). I understand the potential dangers that I could incur in mounting, riding, walking, boarding, and feeding of horses, including but not limited to, any interactions with other horses not owned by myself. Understanding those risks I hereby release Highgrove Farm Inc. and Steve Lantvit Horsemanship Inc., trainers, instructors, clinic assistants, the clinic sponsors, barn owners, managers, employees and auditors, from all claims, demands, action or cause of action of any kind or nature whatsoever, whether now known or ascertained, or which may hereafter develop or accrue me in favor of myself, representatives or dependents, on account of or by reason of any injury (even death), loss, or damage, which may be suffered by me or them, or to any property animate or inanimate, belonging to me or used by me, because of any matter, thing or condition, negligence or default whatsoever and I hereby assume and accept full risk of danger or any hurt, injury or damage which may occur through or by any reason or any matter, thing, or condition, by any person whatsoever.

3). I recognize and agree that I know which equine professional(s) I will be working with, and acknowledge that I agree said equine professional(s) has/have made reasonable and prudent efforts to determine my ability to engage in equine activity, and has/have sufficient knowledge of my equine and horseback riding skills as to relieve, Release and Hold Harmless said equine professional(s) from continuing to monitor my equine activities.

4). I voluntarily agree and warrant to Release and Hold Harmless the equine professionals of Highgrove Farm Inc. and Steve Lantvit Horsemanship Inc. from any liability whatsoever, including, but not limited to, any incident caused by or related to said equine professional(s) negligence, relating to injuries known, unknown, or otherwise not herein disclosed; including, but not limited to injuries, death, or property damage from: mounting; riding; dismounting; walking; grooming; feeding; use of horse barn or paddock or trails or horse arenas or obstacle course, in any capacity; falling off horse whether horse is bucking, flipping, spooked; or my failure to understand any equine professional(s) directions related to my riding or otherwise use and control, or lack thereof, of my horse or any horse that I have been assigned to.

5). I further voluntarily agree and warrant to Release and Hold Harmless Highgrove Farm Inc. and Steve Lantvit Horsemanship Inc. from any liability whatsoever during the time that my horse or a horse that I lease, rent, borrowed, is in the custody or on the premises of Highgrove Farm Inc. and/or Steve Lantvit Horsemanship Inc. and that Highgrove Farm Inc. and Steve Lantvit Horsemanship Inc. shall not be liable for any sickness, disease, theft, death, or injury which may be suffered by the horse. This includes but is not limited to, any personal injury or disability the horse may receive while on Highgrove Farm Inc. premises or in their care or by attending an off-site clinic by Steve Lantvit Horsemanship Inc.. I fully understand and hereby acknowledge that Highgrove Farm Inc. and Steve Lantvit Horsemanship Inc do not carry any insurance on any horse not owned by Highgrove Farm Inc. or Steve Lantvit Horsemanship Inc. and that ALL risks relating to the injury or death of the horse from any reason whatsoever are to be borne by the owner.

Directions to Highgrove Farm

From 94:

1. Take Exit 1 in Michigan (M-239/Harbor Country road) .
2. Head south on MI-239 / Harbor Country road. Crossing into INDIANA.
3. Turn LEFT onto 1000 N. (at the Hesston Steam Museum billboard)
4. Pass 300 E.
5. Right PAST Manna Ln (do not pull into Manna Ln) you will see the Highgrove Farm archway on the left.
6. Turn into the Highgrove Farm archway. Head straight up the hill and stop at the barn.

NOTE: DO NOT pull into Manna Ln. Pull through the Highgrove Farm archway right off of 1000 N.
